

RCLC Contract extension conditions

- CPLC to be paid the full amount for July, August, September. This may require a BAR
- That all efforts to prep for grant renewal be handled by the fiscal agent or staff of another member community. It cannot be me or CPLC
- Due to the timeline of a RFP, that the RFP be administered by a member entity or other contractor.
- As the investigation into the BBER study and overall fiscal impact on the RCLC member communities is becoming a paramount issue, that the board sign a letter to LANL requesting that they authorize BBER to share their financial information with us at a level sufficient to allow us to assess the study methodology and results
- That the Board contracts with BBER or other similar organization to review the study and/or replicate with LANL data. This is EXPENSIVE so the board will have to be willing to dig into their reserves. Following grant renewal that should not be a problem.
- As part of the transition process, CPLC will make available all files and materials in our possession to the Board chair or persons identified by the board. We will also provide all website control credentials and sit with a person designated by the board to go over website mechanics. Sometime in the last month, we will also schedule an exit conference with the board and/or persons identified by the board for handover.
- Due to the mechanics of a transfer, CPLC will not take on additional responsibilities or special projects, unless negotiated ahead of time.

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
